



High School Student ID Lanyard Policy

- ID lanyards are required to be worn by all high school students.
- ID lanyards must be worn upon arrival to campus and up until the student leaves campus every school day.
- ID lanyards must be worn around the neck, on the front of the body, on the outermost clothing, and properly display their current Toledo Christian High School ID Card.
- ID cards and lanyards are school property – they must remain in good condition and not be altered. In the classroom, there may be situations, at the teacher’s discretion, where students may remove their ID lanyards to complete a classroom activity (i.e. P.E., science lab, etc.).
- Toledo Christian High School provides every student a school lanyard and ID free of charge at the beginning of the year. This is the only approved lanyard. Students may not wear lanyards other than the lanyard issued by the school.
- If a student does not have their ID lanyard, they should report to the high school office to obtain a temporary ID lanyard.
 - Loaner lanyards are good for one day.
 - Students are allowed **one** use of a loaner lanyard per semester without penalty. Loaner lanyards must be returned no later than the end of the next day, or a one-hour detention will be issued.
 - The second and third use of a loaner will be accompanied by a one-hour detention per instance.
 - After a student has borrowed a loaner three times, no further loans will be allowed. A new ID and lanyard must be purchased.
- If a student loses his/her ID and/or lanyard, there will be a \$5.00 charge for replacement. The student is responsible for obtaining a new ID by requesting it from Mr. McKellar in the library.
